**THE PUNJAB APPROPRIATION (NO. 1) ACT, 2024**

**(Punjab Act No. 3 of 2024)**

AN

ACT

to provide for the authorization of appropriation of moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Punjab to meet the amounts spent on certain services during the financial years 2019-2020 and 2021-2022, in excess of the amounts authorized or granted for those services and for these years.

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Punjab in the Seventy-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows :-

1. This Act may be called the Punjab Appropriation (No.1) Act, 2024. *Short title.*
2. From and out of the Consolidation Fund of the State of Punjab, the sums specified in column 5 of each of the Schedule I to II, appended to this Act, amounting in the aggregate to the sums of ₹ 468,20,86,289/- (Four hundred sixty eight crore twenty lac eighty six thousand two hundred and eighty nine rupees only), and ₹ 381,25,68,693/- (Three hundred eighty one crore twenty five lac sixty eight thousand six hundred and ninety three rupees only) shall, respectively, be deemed to have been authorized to be paid and applied to meet the amounts spent for defraying the charges in respect of the services specified in column 2 of each of the aforesaid Schedules during the financial years 2019-2020 and 2021-2022, in excess of the amounts authorized or granted for those services and for those years. *Issue of sums out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Punjab to meet certain expenditure for the financial years 2019-2020 and 2021-2022.*
3. The sums deemed to have been authorized to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Punjab under this Act, shall be deemed to have been appropriated for the services and purposes, *Appropriation.*

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Punjab in the Seventy-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Punjab Appropriation (No. 2 ) Act, 2024. Short title.
2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Punjab, there may be paid and applied sums, not exceeding those, specified in column 5 of the Schedule, appended to this Act, amounting, in the aggregate to a sum of ₹ 12046,39,60,000/- (Twelve thousand forty six crore thirty nine lac and sixty thousand rupees only) towards defraying several charges, which will come in the course of payment during the financial year 2023-2024 ending on the thirty-first day of March, 2024, in respect of the services and purposes, specified in column 2 of the said Schedule. Issue of ₹ 12046,39,60,000/- out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Punjab for the financial year, 2023-2024.
3. The sums, authorized to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Punjab by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes, specified in the said Schedule, in relation to the financial year 2023-2024. Appropriation.

Notice is hereby given that the draft will be taken into consideration by the Government on or after the expiry of a period of thirty days from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette, together with an objection or suggestion, which may be received by the Special Secretary Revenue to Government of Punjab, Department of Revenue, Rehabilitation and Disaster Management, from any person before the expiry of the period so specified with respect to the said draft, namely:-

**DRAFT RULES**

1. (1) These rules may be called the Punjab Revenue Kanungos (Group 'C') Service (Amendment) Rules, 2024.

(2) They shall come into force on and with effect from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Punjab Revenue Kanungos (Group 'C') Service Rules, 1994 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), in rule 2,-

(i) after clause (f), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:-

"(fa) '**Head of Department**' means the Director of Land Records, Punjab, or any other officer who is declared as such by the Government;" ; and

**"4. Appointing authority.-** All appointments to the Service shall be made by the Director of Land Records, Punjab."

4. In the said rules, in rule 14, for clause (b), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:-

"(b) by the Director of Land Records, Punjab within the State; and"
